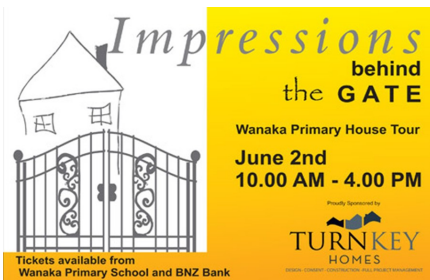


Aspiring Beginnings ELC - New & Views May
